

## Directions for European Access Network Conference 2017 at Giessen University

### From Frankfurt Airport to Giessen


At Frankfurt Airport follow the signs to “Regional trains”. You will need a ticket from the regional transport company “RMV” with the destination “Giessen Bahnhof”, Destination Code 1501. The regular price for an adult is € 15,50. You can take a regional train (RE) or an S-Bahn to “Frankfurt Hauptbahnhof”. There you need to change trains and get a regional train (RB or RE) to Giessen. Check the yellow time tables at any station.

You can also go to [www.bahn.de/en](http://www.bahn.de/en) and check for trips between “Frankfurt(M) Flughafen Regionalbf” and “Giessen” in English. Or put in “Uni Hauptgebäude, Giessen” as a destination to find connections that include a bus transfer from the train station in Giessen to the main building of the University. The bus transfer is included in your ticket from “RMV”.

### From Giessen train station to the university main building (Ludwigstr. 23)

You can walk in 15 minutes (1.3 kilometers) from the train station to the main building of Giessen University, where you will find our conference registration.

Exit the train station in Giessen (green dot on the map) and walk down the main street leading away from the station (Bahnhofstraße). After passing the “Mathematikum” on your right, turn right onto Liebigstraße. Turn left at the main street Frankfurter Straße and after about 200m turn the next street right onto Alicenstraße. Follow the street to its end and turn left onto Ludwigstraße. After crossing two more roads the historic main building of Giessen University is on your right (red dot on the map).




You can also take the bus to get there. There is a direct bus no. 378 to the building leaving every hour at :50 or :55 from bus-platform 3. You can also take busses to “Giessen Johanneskirche” and walk from there. Bus no. 22 departs every hour at :10 also from bus-platform 3, and bus no. 24 departs every half hour :16 and :46 from bus-platform 5. From the bus stop Johanneskirche (orange dot on the map, NW of the red dot) follow the direction of the bus a few meters and turn right onto Goethestraße. Cross two more streets until you arrive at Ludwigstraße. You can already see the historic university building from the intersection.

## Arriving by car

The main university building is also easily accessible by car. From the motorway use the "Schiffenberger Tal" exit. After the exit, drive approximately two kilometers towards Gießen-Stadtmitte - first on Schiffenberger Weg, then on Bismarckstraße. From there, turn left into Stephanstraße. To the right you will find the car park of the university's main building that is now closed off. Try to find a parking spot in the area. The entrance to the main building is on Ludwigstraße at the corner to Goethestraße.

## From university main building to Alte Universitätsbibliothek (AUB, Bismarckstr. 37)

Some sessions take place at the old library of the university, the "Alte Universitätsbibliothek" or AUB. You can walk from the main building in about 5 minutes (400 meters). Exit the main building to the right and walk down Ludwigstraße. Turn the next corner right onto Bismarckstraße and follow Bismarckstraße slightly to the right at the next corner. The entrance to the AUB is on your left after passing the library's grey building with square windows.



## Getting to Mathematikum for the reception on Wednesday evening

The hands-on science museum "Mathematikum" is located close to the train station at the corner of Bahnhofstraße and Liebigstraße. You can use the map and directions from the section "From Gießen train station to the university main building" to find your way to the Mathematikum. It is marked with a yellow dot on that map.

## From the main building of the university to Restaurant heyligenstaedt (Aulweg 41) on Thursday evening

It's a ten-minute walk from the main building to Restaurant heyligenstaedt where we will have dinner on Thursday. Exit the main building to the left and turn left onto Goethestraße. At the end of Goethestraße cross the railway tracks and directly turn right onto Aulweg. Walk down the street. After you cross another railway, the hotel and restaurant heyligenstaedt will be the second building on your left.
